- The children will be bringing 'Breakfast Club' application letters home with them to apply for Breakfast Club 2024/25. All those who want their child / children to join Breakfast Club from September have to apply. Thanks
- The work managed by the local authority on the new Early Years Building is underway and is progressing well. We have been informed in a meeting today that this work will now need to progress to the area connected to the Nursery/Reception main entrance.
 For the safety of children, staff, parents and the contractors we will need to temporarily close the main access to the Nursery and Reception building. From Tuesday 18th June access to the Nursery and Reception building will be via the gate at the other side of the building. We expect that this closure will be in effect until the end of term, but we are working with the contractors to minimise disruption and will reopen the area sooner if it is safe and appropriate to do so.
 The work area will be limited to a small area near the main entrance, this area will be fully enclosed with fencing to ensure the children can still access the outdoor play areas and outdoor classroom.
- Please don't forget the PTA 'Rags to Riches' project. If you are having a clear out, please fill a bag of clothes and bring the bag back to school. Pick up will be Friday 28thJune.
